Under this program, qualified full and part-time students attending any university, community college or technical college in the state of Kansas are eligible for scholarship awards. #### Qualifications

To be qualified for the WMA scholarship, the applicant must:

- Be a high school or GED (General Education Diploma) graduate,
- Be enrolled fulltime (12 or more credit hours or clock hour equivalent), or be enrolled part-time (6 or more credit hours or clock hour equivalent), if employed in manufacturing,
- Attend any university, community college or technical college in Kansas,
- Be interested in a manufacturing related career, and
- Be a U.S. citizen and resident of Kansas.

#### Number of Scholarships

WMA funds, bylaws and policies, and independent underwriting by member and community companies and organizations will determine the number of scholarships awarded each year.

#### **Amount Paid/How Paid**

Each scholarship will be \$1,000.00 and will be awarded for one year for use towards tuition or related education expenses. Upon confirmation of admission and enrollment, the scholarship will be paid to your College. In the event the student withdraws, the WMA will be refunded in accordance with the educational institution's refund policy. Each scholarship winner is required to attend the WMA Scholarship Awards Banquet to receive a commemorative certificate.

- A brief essay (maximum 300 words) about why the applicant believes they deserve the scholarship, a brief description of their career goals, and their plans for after graduation, and
- A high school or GED transcript or most current college transcripts.
