ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Provide a receipt from a professional massage therapist for completion of a 60 minute massage
- Provide required documentation:
 - 1. CPR certification
 - 2. Documentation of TB Skin Test within the last two years
 - 3. Physical examination within the last year

Frequently Asked Questions

When can I start the Massage Therapy program?

The Massage Therapy program offers starting points in the Summer, Fall, and Spring.

What can of testing requirements are needed for the program?

Students are required to take one of the following for placement testing:

(assessment scores can be no older than 3 years)

ACT: English - 18 AND Writing - 15, Math - 19

SAT: Writing - 480 AND Reading - 45, Math - 440

Accuplacer Writing 255 AND Reading - 255 Ed Ready General Math Initial Diagnostic - 56

What kind of jobs can I get as a Massage Therapist?

The line of work to expect is to work in Spas, Chiropractors Clinics, Massage Therapist Clinics, Sports and Massaging Clinics

Is there a dress code for this program?

Yes, students will wear a school provided shirt and blue, black, or khaki pants, and tennis shoes at all times.

Are there any licensing requirements?

Are there any prerequisite general education classes to complete before starting Massage Therapy courses?

No, but it is recommended that students complete Composition I, Medical Terminology, and a Communications elective (either Public Speaking or Interpersonal Communication) before taking Massage Therapy coursework.
