This degree is our technical certificate for LPN, in addition to 10 credit hours in leadership and management for LPN's so that they will have some supervisory background prior to going to work in the clinics and long term care facilities. Additionally with the approval of this degree from the Board and ultimately from KBOR our LPN students will be fully degree bound which will provide them financial assistance as they seek to secure grants and loans for their education. Also requesting an approval for a new degree that KBOR is offering which only requires our Board approval. It is an AAS degree in Technical Studies, which provides us a degree path for students where they can integrate 30 hours of technical training from two different disciplines along with 15 hours of general education for their degree. This degree option will be a nice addition to our other AAS degrees, especially since we cannot offer an Associate of Arts or Science degree.
