	SB155 funds should be received in early January. On the balance sheet, accounts receivable decreased \$169,000 as students made payments on tuition and fees for the fall semester.
	Cash set aside in the reserve accounts is \$4.2 million. The college will replace NCAT parking lot lights to LEDs and we will be using \$50,000 from the maintenance fund.
