ABOUT THE CAMPS

WSU Tech's Summer Camp programming is designed to inspire and engage students in 3rd through 8th grades in hands-on STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) experiences. Through a curriculum that combines experiential learning, industry mentorship, and cutting-edge technology, students will engage in a wide variety of activities including robotics, automation, drones, AI, welding, pilot, HVAC, and healthcare – just to name a few.

Through the Girls Rock Science Camp, {new} boys Grit & Gears Camp, and TechKnow Middle School Camps, more than 1,200 elementary and middle school students from underserved and underrepresented zip codes in Wichita will participate in the programming each summer.

Registration fee scholarships are available for those who request assistance.



Girls Rock Science

This camp spans four days and engages 200 girls in 3rd - 8th grades all things STEAM -- from learning how a robot works to practicing CODE, to seeing imagination come to life through a 3D printer, to exploring what makes an airplane fly! Campers work together to solve problems and compete in challenges aimed at giving them a taste of the fun in STEAM careers.



Grit & Gears

New to 2025, WSU Tech introduces Grit & Gears Camp, an exciting expansion of the popular Girls Rock Science Camp. Designed to engage 200 3rd - 8th graders, this camp immerses boys in the world of STEAM through interactive challenges, problem-solving activities, and real-world applications. Campers will build, create, and explore innovative projects, fostering curiosity, teamwork, and resilience.



TechKnow Middle School Camp

This camp spans eight days and introduces 800 middle school students to career possibilities in industries from healthcare, welding, esports, IT, drones, criminal justice and more. Through interactive workshops, real-world problem-solving, and industry connections, students explore future careers while building critical thinking and technical skills.

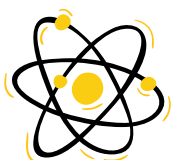
