Dependent Student

Additional situations when you must file a 2019 Tax Return

If you can answer yes to any of the below, you must file a 2019 tax return:

- You owe special taxes (please see IRS Table 1-3 at <u>www.irs.gov</u> for details)
- You or spouse (if filing jointly) received HSA, Archer MSA, or Medicare Advantage MSA distribution
- You had net earnings from self-employment of at least \$400
- You had wages of \$108.28 or more from a church or qualified church-controlled organization that is exempt from employer social security and Medicare taxes
- Advance payments of those enrolled through the Marketplace as indicated on form 1095-A you received
