Dependent Student

	If you cannot be claimed as a dependent on someone else's taxes and your filing status is:	<i>then, you were not</i> required to file if your gross income was less than:
	Single	\$12,400
<i>and</i> your unearned income* was less than:	If someone can claim you as a dependent on their taxes and your filing status is:	<i>then, you were not</i> required to file if your earned income was less than:
\$1,100	Dependent	\$12,400

Independent Student/Parent(s) of a Dependent Student

If your filing status is:	<i>and</i> at the end of 2020, you were:	<i>then, you were not</i> required to file if your gross income was less than:
Single	Under 65 65 or older	\$12,400 \$14,050
Married filing jointly	Under 65 (both spouses) 65 or older (one spouse) 65 or older (both spouses)	\$24,800 \$26,100 \$27,400
Married filing separately	Any age	\$5
Head of Household	Under 65 65 or older	\$18,650 \$20,300
Qualifying widow(er) with dependent child(ren)	Under 65 65 or older	\$24,800 \$26,100

Additional situations when you must file a 2020 Tax Return

If you can answer yes to any of the below, you must file a 2020 tax return:

- You owe special taxes (please see IRS Table 1-3 at www.irs.gov for details)
- You or spouse (if filing jointly) received HSA, Archer MSA, or Medicare Advantage MSA distribution
- You had net earnings from self-employment of at least \$400
- You had wages of \$108.28 or more from a church or qualified church-controlled organization that is exempt from employer social security and Medicare taxes
- Advance payments of those enrolled through the Marketplace as indicated on form 1095-A you received

Requesting Tax Transcripts/Wage and Income Transcripts
