Policy Statement

Non-Students in the Classroom

Only WSU Tech students who have been officially admitted, enrolled and listed on the class roster and non-student individuals with prior approval from WSU Tech administration, may attend a class at the College.

Non-Students on Campus

Non-students may be excluded from certain areas of the campus reserved for student use or College operations, including but not limited to laboratories, testing centers, and offices. These particular areas may implement their own guidelines regarding access by non-students.

Non-students on campus are expected to conduct themselves in accordance with all federal and state laws and regulations and a manner consistent with all WSU Tech Policies and Procedures. Any violations of these laws and/or Policies and Procedures could result in corrective action taken by the College.

Unattended Children on Campus

Children should not be left unattended on campus in a manner that presents a safety or health risk to the child or campus community or disrupts College operations. College personnel cannot be responsible for overseeing children who are left unattended and may contact the WSU Tech Security team for intervention if a child is found left unattended.
