Policy Statement

All WSU Tech courses have some form of digital instructional content that must be accessed by digital devices like laptops and tablets.

Adult Student Requirement for Laptops/Tablets

WSU Tech adult students are required to have access to a portable digital device like a laptop or tablet to use in class and for completion of coursework

Personally owned devices must meet the following standards:

- Microsoft Windows 10 or newer
- Must run the current version of Google Chrome Web Browser
- Must run the current version of Microsoft Office Applications
- Must have a webcam and microphone for Zoom videoconferencing
- Minimum of 3-hour battery life
- Minimum of 10-inch screen (12 inches or larger recommended)
- Keyboard recommended
- Minimum 32 GB storage (64 GB or larger is recommended)
- Either USB port or Micro SD card slot for additional storage
- WIFI capability 802.11ac or 802.11n

*Note: Certain courses may have additional computer requirements, including but not limited to Design, CATIA, or Professional Pilot. Students should visit with their academic advisor for specific program digital device requirements.
