ASSOCIATE OF ARTS DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Earn credit for 60 cumulative hours.

Earn a minimum of 15 hours at WSU.

Earn a minimum of 48 hours in Liberal Arts and Sciences coursework.

Complete all general education requirements.

Maintain an overall, WSU and cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher.

FINE ARTS AND WSU GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Earn credit for 120 cumulative hours.

Earn credit in a minimum of 60 hours at a 4-year institution.

Earn credit in a minimum of 45 hours of upper-division coursework.

Complete all general education requirements.

Maintain an overall, WSU, and program GPA of 2.00 or higher and at least a C or better in all required major courses. At least 24 of last 30 or 50 of last 60 credit hours must be completed at WSU.
