Program Requirements

The Health Management major consists of 11-12 credits of pre-program preparatory course (some also fulfill general education requirements); 15 credits of core courses; and 36 credits in a concentration area. Please visit www.wichita.edu/phs for full degree requirements.

Students will then select a 36-hour concentration from: Aging Studies, Public Health or Health Administration.

The Bachelor of Science degree in Health Management establishes a professional degree program that prepares graduates for employment in health care, public health organizations and aging programs/services. Individuals interested in applying the social and business sciences to a career in the health care sector are well-suited for this program.

Students complete a health management core curriculum that serves as the foundation and skill set basic to health services delivery, population health assessment and leadership. Additional elective courses in areas related to aging studies, clinical health care management or public health is required. A capstone seminar and health-related practicum (educational work experience) is required. Students are strongly encouraged to choose a minor to complement their career choice.

Graduates go on to manage health clinics, senior living communities, quality improvement departments, infectious disease control programs or community health organizations. The BS in health management also prepares students for graduate education in health care administration, public health, or aging studies.



AA Graduation Requirements

Earn credit for 60 cumulative hours.

Earn a minimum of 15 hours at WSU.

Earn a minimum of 48 hours in Liberal Arts and Sciences coursework.

Complete all general education requirements.

Maintain an overall, WSU and cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher.



BS in Health Management Graduation Requirements

Earn credit for **120** cumulative hours. *Elective hours needed.*

Earn credit in a minimum of 60 hours at a 4-year institution.

Earn credit in a minimum of 45 hours of upper-division coursework at a 4-year institution.

Complete all general education requirements.

Maintain an overall, WSU, and program GPA of 2.0 or higher.

At least 24 of last 30 or 50 of last 60 credit hours must be completed at WSU.
