Program Requirements

The Health Science major consists of 17-18 credits hours of pre-program preparatory courses (some also fulfill general education requirements); 15 credits of core courses; and a minimum of 15 hours in specified sciences. Please visit www.wichita.edu/phs for full degree requirements.

The Bachelor of Science degree in Health Science is a 47- to 48-credit-hour professional degree program that prepares graduates for admission to a clinical education program. Students complete a curriculum that provides a foundation in health services delivery, population health assessment and leadership.

Additional program content includes an introduction to public health, health services management, aging studies and ethics. This program requires a mix of science and mathematics courses that support admission requirements for a variety of clinical education programs. Students are required to complete an applied learning professional portfolio prior to graduation.

The degree is designed for students interested in pursuing undergraduate or graduate clinical education. Baccalaureate trained graduates often seek further education in clinical programs (i.e. physician assistant, physical therapy, nursing, medical laboratory sciences, dental hygiene).



AA Graduation Requirements

Earn credit for **60** cumulative hours.

Earn a minimum of 15 hours at WSU.

Earn a minimum of 48 hours in Liberal Arts and Sciences coursework.

Complete all general education requirements.

Maintain an overall, WSU and cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher.



BS in Health Science Graduation Requirements

Earn credit for **120** cumulative hours. *Elective hours needed.*

Earn credit in a minimum of <u>60</u> hours at a 4-year institution.

Earn credit in a minimum of **45** hours of upper-division coursework at a 4-year institution.

Complete all general education requirements.

Maintain an overall, WSU, and program GPA of 2.0 or higher. At least 24 of last 30 or 50 of last 60 credit hours must be completed at WSU.
