Program Application and Admission Requirements

Students considering the nursing program are strongly encouraged to meet with a Wichita State University College of Health Professions advisor spring of their freshman year to discuss the application process if they wish to enter the program their junior year.

After completion of general education coursework and 15 hours at WSU, students may choose to be awarded the Associate of Arts.

Minimum Overall GPA for Traditional Program is 2.75. Minimum Overall GPA for Accelerated Program is 3.0. Competitive Overall GPA for BOTH is 3.4 or higher.

AA Graduation Requirements

Earn credit for 60 cumulative hours.

Earn a minimum of 15 hours at WSU.

Earn a minimum of 48 hours in Liberal Arts and Sciences coursework.

Complete all general education requirements.

Maintain an overall, WSU and cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher.



BS in Nursing Graduation Requirements

Earn credit for 120 cumulative hours. Elective hours needed.

Earn credit in a minimum of **60** hours at a 4-year institution. The Nursing professional program totals 54 credits.

Transfer students may need additional coursework to meet this requirement.

Earn credit in a minimum of 45 hours of upper-division coursework at a 4-year institution.

Complete all general education requirements.

Maintain an overall, WSU, and program GPA of 2.0 or higher.

At least 24 of last 30 or 50 of last 60 credit hours must be completed at WSU.
