Maintain an overall, WSU and cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher.



# Philosophy Graduation Requirements

Earn credit for 120 cumulative hours.

Earn credit in a minimum of **60** hours at a 4-year institution.

Earn credit in a minimum of **45** hours of upper-division coursework at a 4-year institution.

Complete all general education requirements.

Maintain an overall, WSU, and program GPA of 2.50 or higher.

At least 24 of last 30 or 50 of last 60 credit hours must be completed at WSU.
