Successfully complete the NLN NEX

- Composite NLN NEX score must be a minimum of 138
- Verbal NLN NEX score must be a minimum of 63
- \$55 per testing session and a photo ID is required
- NEX can be taken no more than three times per application period

Test results are valid for three years.



After applicant applies to WSU Tech, they must enroll in the Associate Degree Nurse (A.D.N.) Information Session
This course is free and is available in the traditional face to face format. The course is required to be considered for the program and all sessions are scheduled for March.

DEADLINES: All requirements must be completed by May 31st * for the Fall semester.

Please check with your Academic Advisor for enrollment details.

Bring a laptop, notebook, and pen to the Information Session. WSU TECH is not able to accommodate children.

If deadline falls on a weekend all requirements are due the Friday before

ACCEPTANCE

When all above requirements are met, applicants are eligible for selection. Students are selected based on merit, including but not limited to: grades and test scores.

*Upon acceptance into the program applicants must complete the following requirements by specified dates:

- **Health Examinations and Immunizations:** Applicants must complete health examinations and obtain all required immunizations at their own expense. Applicants will be required to be up to date on the COVID-19 vaccination as defined by current CDC guidelines.
- Criminal Background Check and Drug Screen: Applicants must pay for and pass both.
- *As required by WSU Tech policy, any felony and/or crimes against a person preclude admission to health programs. NURSE_PRACTICE ACT_STATUTES_& ADMINISTRATIVE_REGULATIONS_Statute 65-1120.

Resubmitting Application

Applicants must enroll in another information session course to re-apply for the next Associate Degree Nurse program start.



ASSOCIATE DEGREE NURSE (A.D.N.)

The Associate Degree Nurse (A.D.N.) program provides the common body of knowledge and skills essential for the associate degree nurse's entry into practice. The curriculum fulfills the educational requirements for licensure as a associate degree nurse (A.D.N.).

Upon completion of the program, graduates are eligible to take the NCLEX-ADN examination. There are pathways for articulation to degree nursing programs.
