2 Request official transcripts (High School and College)

- High School or GED transcripts: Official transcripts must be mailed or transferred electronically directly from the issuing institution and received by the Registrar prior to registration. Official transcripts must be in a sealed envelope upon receipt and may not be stamped "student copy."
- College transcripts: Request official transcripts be sent from each institution from which coursework is to be transferred. Transfer credits must have been earned at an accredited institution. Equivalent coursework for which students have earned a letter grade of a 'C' or better is considered for transfer. Official transcripts must be mailed or transferred electronically directly from the issuing institution and received by the Registrar prior to registration. Official transcripts must be in a sealed envelope upon receipt.

4 Complete Placement Exams.

- Minimum Required Scores: Next Generation Accuplacer Reading – 240, Next Generation Accuplacer Writing – 237 and EdReady General Math – 39 Placement tests are free the first time you take each one. To schedule with the testing center, please call 316-677-9506.
- A photo ID is required to take the assessments. Results are valid for three years
- College transcripts with credit for English Composition I and Intermediate Algebra with a minimum grade of 'C' can be accepted in place of an entrance exam.
