2 Request official transcripts

- College transcripts: Request official transcripts be sent from each institution from which coursework is to be transferred. Transfer credits must have been earned at an accredited institution. Equivalent coursework for which students have earned a letter grade of a 'C' or better is considered for transfer. Official transcripts must be mailed or transferred electronically directly from the issuing institution and received by the Registrar prior to registration. Official transcripts must be in a sealed envelope upon receipt.

3 Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

File the 2026-2027 FAFSA at studentaid.gov

WSU Tech Financial Aid department should receive students' information within 3-5 business days.

*Additional information may be required before students' financial aid packets can be fully processed.

4 Complete Placement Exams.

- Minimum Required Scores: Next Generation Accuplacer Reading – 237, Next Generation Accuplacer Writing – 237, and ALEKS math – 30. The Reading and Writing tests are free the first time you take them. The ALEKS test is \$25, but you can retake the test 5 times to improve your score.
- Call 316-677-9506 to schedule placement test.
- A photo ID is required to take the assessments. Results are valid for three years
- ACT scores taken within the last three years can be substituted for the ACCUPLACER Next Generation and ALEKS tests. Must have minimum scores of: English - 18, Reading - 18, Math - 19
- College transcripts with credit for English Composition I and College Algebra with a minimum grade of 'C' can be accepted in place of entrance exams.
