The Mental Health Technician program trains students for entry-level positions to care for patients with mental or behavioral health challenges. The curriculum explores key mental health topics, providing students with the knowledge and skills to support patients in diverse settings, including hospitals, mental health clinics, intake and assessment centers, outpatient behavioral health facilities, and intensive daycare programs.

Upon completion, students are prepared to take the licensing exam through the Kansas State Board of Nursing (KSBN).
